

A catalog of the types of Stratiomyidae, Tabanidae, Asilidae *sensu lato*, and Syrphidae (Insecta, Diptera) deposited in the Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales, Buenos Aires (MACN)

With an appendix on types of Tabanidae deposited in the Instituto “Dr. Carlos G. Malbrán”, Buenos Aires (ANLIS)

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Abstract: The type specimens of all accepted categories of three names of Stratiomyidae, fifty-nine of Tabanidae, twenty-four of Asilidae *sensu lato* (includes Leptogastridae), and twenty of Syrphidae are recorded. In an *appendix* twelve paratypes of six species of Tabanidae are recorded, housed in the Administración Nacional de Laboratorios e Institutos de Salud “Dr. Carlos G. Malbrán” (ANLIS), Departamento Vectores, Buenos Aires.

Resumen: Catálogo de los tipos de Stratiomyidae, Tabanidae, Asilidae *sensu lato*, y Syrphidae (Insecta, Diptera) depositados en el Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales, Buenos Aires (MACN). Con un apéndice sobre tipos de Tabanidae depositados en el Instituto “Dr. Carlos G. Malbrán”, Buenos Aires (ANLIS). Se registran los ejemplares tipo de todas las categorías aceptadas de tres nombres de Stratiomyidae, cincuenta y nueve de Tabanidae, veinticuatro de Asilidae *s. l.* (incluye Leptogastridae) y veinte de Syrphidae. En un *appendix* se registran doce paratipos, de seis especies de Tabanidae, depositados en la Administración Nacional de Laboratorios e Institutos de Salud “Dr. Carlos G. Malbrán” (ANLIS), Departamento Vectores, Buenos Aires.

INTRODUCTION

A catalog of the type specimens of Stratiomyidae, Tabanidae, Asilidae *s. l.* (including Leptogastridae), and Syrphidae, housed in the Entomological Division of this Museum is presented. They correspond to 3 + 59 + 24 + 20 names. In an *appendix* 12 paratypes of 6 species of Tabanidae, housed in the Administración Nacional de Laboratorios e Institutos de Salud “Dr. Carlos G. Malbrán” (ANLIS), Departamento Vectores, Buenos Aires, are recorded.

The species of Stratiomyidae listed were described by Jean Brèthes (1922) and Everard E. Blanchard (1938), whose collections were deposited long ago in this Museum; most of the species of Tabanidae listed were described by Jean Brèthes (1911), and several others by Sixto

Coscarón and collaborators (1961/1993); most of the species of Asilidae listed were described by Enrique Lynch Arribálzaga (1880/1883), and a few by Emilio Gemignani (1930/1931) and Gerardo Lamas (1973), and those of Syrphidae by Félix Lynch Arribálzaga (1891/1892) and Jean Brèthes (1905/1920).

Specific and subspecific names, grouped by families, are alphabetically filed in single series, followed by the generic ones, in their original spellings. An account of the types actually here housed is given, with descriptions of all the labels. When no types were formally designated, and the amount of specimens examined was not mentioned, it is assumed that there was a series of syntypes (recommendation 73F of the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature, 1999), eventually ‘single syntypes’. In geo-

graphical mentions, if the country is not stated, Argentina is meant.

For the taxonomic and nomenclatural updating, the catalogs of James (1973) for the Stratiomyidae, those of Fairchild (1971) and Coscarón & Papavero (2009) for the Tabanidae, those of Martin & Papavero (1970) and Lamas (1973b) for the Asilidae, and that of Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976) for the Syrphidae are here followed.

Some types deemed to be housed in the Museum were not found, but in order to assist future research, they are recorded in separate lists. Some specimens labeled as types are not acceptable, or very hardly acceptable as conforming a type series, but also in order to assist in future research, they are included in further lists.

Barretto & Duret deposited in the Museum in 1955 a series of specimens of Tabanidae, labeled as types, planning to publish the descriptions of fourteen new species, along with the designations of several lectotypes, but owing to the death of Barretto, nothing was published (Duret, personal communication XII.1997); I accept their rotulation as Holotypes and Allotypes of specimens identified by them; once more in order to assist future research, they are filed in a separate list. In the meantime Duret also passed (as late as 2007, at 94 years).

In his descriptions, Coscarón included very often characters of the female *genitalia*, dissecting the last abdominal segments, but only seldom the corresponding slides were found, neither in this Museum nor in ANLIS, where Coscarón stayed many years as an active entomologist.

All the type specimens, and also those which were intended as types, but were not published, bear a small reverted label referred to the data base of the Museum, as "MACN-En 0000"; specimen information is currently managed with the application Aurora (Rodríguez 2007-2011). Several specimens bear a small, red framed label, with a number entered in the register book of the Entomology Division of the Museum; numbers under 10000 refer to the old general register book of the Museum.

CATALOG OF THE TYPES

Stratiomyidae

bonariensis [*Udamacantha*]. Brèthes 1922: 139–140. Buenos Aires Prov.: Mosconi, F.C.S., 12.VI.1920, leg. F. Sathicq.

Two synt. pinned, one without head, "Mosconi (F.C.S.) / 12.XI.1920 / F. Sathicq" handwr. by Brèthes; "Udamacantha / bonariensis Br." handwr. by Brèthes; "type!" handwr. by Brèthes; a small square of red paper. A **slide** with an antenna, "Udamacantha / bonariensis Brèthes / type! / (Stratiomyidae) / Mosconi (F.C.S.) / 12.XI.1920 / F. Sathicq leg." handwr. by Brèthes, in slide coll. *sub U.1. "MACN-En / 7688 [7689]" print., reverse.*

Notes: F.C.S. means Ferrocarril del Sud, currently Línea Roca of the Argentine railway system. *Udamacantha* Enderlein 1914 has *Labostigmina* Enderlein 1930 as a synonym, *fide* James (1973: 42).

minor [*Hadrestia*]. Brèthes 1924: 104. Chile: Chiloé Is., L. Moreira leg., *prope H. aenea*.

minor [*Hadrestia*]: Woodley 1995: 109. **Lectot.** and **one paralect.** designated.

Lectot. ♀, **paralect.** ♂ pinned, right foreleg, left hindtarsus, and right wing missing at the lectot; the paralect. with a plastic microvial containing dissected parts, "Chiloé / I.1923 / L. Moreira" handwr. by Brèthes; "type!", "Hadrestia / minor Brèthes" handwr. by Brèthes; "Lectotype ♀ [Paralectotype ♂] [print.] / minor / Brèthes 1924: 104 [handwr.] / det. N.E. Woodley 1995 [print.]" on red [yellow] paper; "Hadrestia / aenea / Thomson [handwr.] / det. Woodley 1995 [print.]". "MACN-En / 7690 [7691]" print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded as *Hadrestia minor* by James (1973: 6). A synonym of *Hadrestia aenea* Thomson, *fide* Woodley (1995: 109), who designates lectot. and one paralect.

xanthipes [*Ptecticus*]. Blanchard 1938: 347–348. Tucumán Prov.: Lules, on orange-trees V.1938, E. Schultz leg. **Cotypes** in author's coll.

Four synt. on cards, **two of them** without head; one further spec. missing on the card. "Tucumán / Schultz V.38" handwr., date hardly legible, black frame. **One of them:** "Ptecticus / xanthipes / n. sp. [handwr.] / det. E.E. Blanchard [print.]", black frame. To the other four I add "Ptecticus / xanthipes / n. sp. / det. E.E. Blanchard / Syntypus" handwr. on red paper. "MACN-En / 7683 [7684, 7685, 7686, 7687]" print., reverse.

Note: The name was not recorded by James (1973).

Tabanidae

acer [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 478. Buenos Aires Prov.: Tandil.

One ♂, two ♀ synt. pinned, “Argentina [print.] / Tandil [handwr.] / Bs. Aires [print.]”, black frame; “*Tabanus / acer* Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “Cotypus” print. on pink paper, black frame. The ♂, also “7899” handwr., black frame; “Lectotipo” print. on pink paper, black frame. The ♀ also “Aloparatipo” handwr. on pink paper (refers to *T. melanogaster*, *quo vide*); “*Tabanus / melanogaster* Brèthes / Barr. & Dur. det. 955” handwr.; one of them “J. Brèthes / Buenos Aires / 20.XI.1903” handwr. by Brèthes, black frame. “MACN-En / 7692 [7693, 7694]” print., reverse. Notes: Both “paralect.” are also mentioned *sub Tabanus melanogaster*. See also under *Tabanus distinctus*, below, and under *T. acer* in the last list. No lectot. designation was published. Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 123) say *Tabanus distinctus* is a synonym.

albibasis [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 477. Formosa Prov.

albibasis [*Leucotabanus*]: Fairchild 1941: 636–637, f. 2a, b.

Holot. pinned, “Moconá / Ambrosetti” handwr., black frame; “Argentina / Formosa” print., black frame; “*Tabanus / albibasis* Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “Holotypus” print. on pink paper, black frame; “*Leucotabanus / albibasis* (Brèth.) / Barr. & Dur. det. 1955” handwr. **One parat.** pinned, “*Tabanus / albibasis* / Brèth. [handwr.] / Mus. Nac. Hist. Natural Buenos Aires [print.]”, black frame, a small triangle of red paper; “*Leucotabanus / ? bejaranoi* n. sp. / Barretto et Duret, 955” handwr.; “O” handwr. with pencil on pale violet paper, reverse white. “MACN-En / 7695” print., reverse.

Note: Recorded under *Leucotabanus* by Fairchild (1941: 636–637) and by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 95).

ameghinoi (*sub Ameghinoi*) [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 478. Buenos Aires Prov.

Holot. pinned, “Buen / Ayres” print. on green paper; “280” handwr., red frame; “Col. / Antigua” print. on whitish paper, black frame; “Holotypus” print. on pink paper, black frame; “*Taeniotabanus / desertus* (Walk.) / Barr. & Dur. det. 955” handwr. “MACN-En / 7696” print., reverse.

Notes: A synonym of *Tabanus claripennis* (Bigot) *fide* Coscarón & Philip (1967a: 124; 1967b: 254)

and Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 126), who also mention *hookeri* Knab, *ovalipalpus* Enderlein, *pygmaeus* Enderlein, *flavifrons* Szilády, *frontosus* Kröber, *?venezuelensis* Kröber, *pulchella* Kröber, *pulcher* Kröber, *pusio* Kröber as synonyms. Labeled *Taeniotabanus desertus* (Walker) by Barretto & Duret, 1955.

antilope [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 480. Buenos Aires and Santa Cruz Prov.

antilope [*Dasybasis*]: Coscarón & Philips 1967b: 54–56, pl. 10: A–K.

Three synt. ♀ pinned, “Santa / Cruz” handwr. on green paper, black frame, reverse white; “6317” handwr., red frame; “852” handwr.; “*Tabanus / antilope* Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “Cotypus” print. on pink paper, remainings of a black frame; “Lectotipo” [“Paralectotipo”, “Paralectotipo”] print. on pink paper, black frame; “*Agelanius / antilope* (Brèth.) / Barr. & Dur. det. 1955” handwr. **Five synt** pinned, “Bs. Aires [print.] / Bahia / Blanca [handwr.]” on green paper, black frame, reverse white; “6549” handwr., red frame; “852” handwr.; “Cotypus” print. on pink paper; **four of them** “*Agelanius / sp.* / Barr. & Dur. det. 955” handwr., **one of them** “*Tabanus / antilope* Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; **one of them** “?Agelanius? / bonariensis (Macq.) / Barr. & Dur. det. 955” handwr. To the remaining four I add “*Tabanus / antilope / Brèthes*” handwr., black frame. “MACN-En / 7697 [7698 through 7703]” print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded under *Dasybasis* by Coscarón & Philip (1967a: 101; 1967b: 54–56), under *Dasybasis (Dasybasis)* by Fairchild (1971: 37) and under *Dasybasis* by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 70). The “Lectotipo” label was put by Barretto & Duret, but the designation was not published. The entry 6317 in the old general register book of the Museum refers to three tabanids from Santa Cruz Prov., as a gift from Aníbal Cardoso; the entry 6549 refers to thirty-four dipters from Buenos Aires Prov.: Bahía Blanca, trip of Emilio Gemignani, and the number of the entry was restricted for five spec. of *Tabanus antilope*.

aquila [?*Dasybasis* [(*Agelanius*)]]. Coscarón & Philip 1967a: 98, 103. Southern Chile. In a key.

One parat. pinned, “Lago Frías / 17-I-66 / Col.: Castro” handwr.; “Paratipo” print. on pink paper, black frame; “?Dasybasis / aquila n. sp. / det. Coscarón y Philip / 1966” handwr. “MACN-En / 7704” print. reverse.

Note: Recorded under *Agelanius* by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 58).

argentina [*Chrysozona*]. Brèthes 1911: 483–484, 1 f. Chubut, San Juan and Catamarca Prov.
argentinus [*Archiplatius*]: Enderlein 1925: 373.

argentina [*Haematopotina*]: Coscarón & Papavero 2009: 92. Type species of the genus.
One synt. pinned, “Catamarca” running handwr. with red ink; “7623” handwr., black frame; “Lectotipo” print. on pink paper, black frame. **One synt.** pinned, left wing missing, “S. Juan” handwr. on green paper, black frame, reverse white; “7628” handwr., red frame; “Paralectotipo” print. on pink paper, black frame. **Both:** “Cotypus” print. on red paper, black frame; “Chrysozona / argentina Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “Stenotabanus / argentinus (Brèth.) / Barr. & Dur. det. 955” handwr. “MACN-En / 7705 [7706]” print., reverse.

arvensis [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 479. Salta Prov.

arvensis [*Dicladocera*]: Coscarón 1967a: 113.

“Dicladocera / nubipennis / (Rondani) / det. Coscarón 1966” handwr. with blue ink. “MACN-En / 7708” print., reverse.

[handwr.]” on red paper. “MACN-En / 7709 [7710]” print., reverse.

bellicosus [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 479. Salta Prov.

bellicosa [*Dicladocera*]: Coscarón 1967a: 114. Salta, Tucumán.

Holot. pinned, “Salta” handwr. on green paper; “267” handwr., red frame; “Col. / Antigua” print. on whitish paper, black frame; “Tabanus / bellicosus Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “Holotypus” print. on pink paper, black frame; “Chelommia / bellicosa (Brèth.) / Barr. & Dur. det. 955” handwr.; “888” handwr. “MACN-En / 7712” print., reverse.

Note: Recorded under *Dicladocera* by Coscarón (1967a: 114) and by Fairchild (1971: 73), with

Stylochela neominos Philip 1960 as a synonym, and under *Dicladocera* (*Dicladocera*) by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 89). Labeled *Chełommia bellucosa* by Barreto & Duret (1955).

boliviensis [*Acanthocerella*]. Brèthes 1911: 476, 1 f. Bolivia: Chiquitos.

boliviensis [*Dichelacera*]: Fairchild & Philip 1960: 21–22.

One synt. pinned, “Bolivia / Chiquitos / Col. Koslowsky” print., black frame; “7719” handwr., black frame; “*Acanthocerella* / *boliviensis* Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “829” handwr. “MACN-En / 7713” print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded under *Dichelacera* by Fairchild & Philip (1960: 21–22), and under *Dichelacera* (*Dichelacera*) by Fairchild (1971: 61) and Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 82).

bonariensis [*Chrysops*]. Brèthes 1911: 474.

Note: Recorded as *Chrysops bonariensis* by Fairchild (1971: 30) and by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 9).

One synt. ♀ pinned, “Catamarca” handwr. with red ink; “872”, “2582” handwr.; “*Tabanus* / *Bruchi* Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “*Cotyplus*” print. on pink paper, remainings of a black frame; “*Lectotipo*” printed on pink paper, black frame; “*Agelanius* / *bruchi* (Brèth.) / Barr. + Dur. det. 955” handwr. “MACN-En / 7715” print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded under *Dasybasis* by Coscarón & Philip (1967a: 100; 1967b: 73–75) and by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 71), and as *Dasybasis* (*Dasybasis*) *bruchi* by Fairchild (1971: 37). Lectotype designation not published.

caprii [*Dasybasis*]. Coscarón & Philip 1967a: 102, 103. In a key, Central Western Argentina.

Notes: Recorded under *Dasybasis* (*Dasybasis*) by Fairchild (1971: 38), and under *Dasybasis* by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 71). Slide with ♀ genit. not found. See at the addendum for an additional parat. in ANLIS.

copelloi (*sub Copelloi*). [*M.[allophora]*]. Gemignani 1930: 138. La Rioja Prov., 11762, Giacomelli leg., **holot.** ♂ in MACN.

Holot.? pinned, right hind leg and parts of other legs missing, «paratypus» handwr. with red ink on red painted paper; «*Mallophora / copelloi / Gemign.*» handwr. on grayish white paper; «11762» handwr., red frame; «La Rioja» handwr. on green paper, black frame, reverse white; «synonymous of / M. robusta (Wied.)» typed; "Museo Nacional / Buenos Aires" handwr. "MACN-En / 7617" print., reverse.

Notes: Only the holotype was mentioned, so the label "paratypus" is puzzling. Recorded as *Mallophora copelloi* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 73).

costalis [*Dasypogon*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 29–33. Buenos Aires: Belgrano.

One synt. pinned, left wing missing, right one damaged, "♀" print.; a small square of dirty white paper; "Dasypogon / costalis E.L.A." handwr., folded; "Sintipo" handwr. on pink paper. "MACN-En / 7674" print., reverse.

Notes: Belgrano is now a district in Buenos Aires City. Recorded as "Gen.? *costalis*" by Martin & Papavero (1970: 88), who add that the neotropical species of *Dasypogon* probably refer to another genus.

cruentus [*Prostacanthus*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 364–265. Misiones.

dallasi (*sub Dallasi*) [*Mallophora*]. Gemignani 1931: 264–265. "Chaco-Formosa", 26719, **holot.** ♂, **allot.** ♀ in MACN.

Holot. ♂, allot. ♀ pinned, the **allot.** with a part of the abdomen glued on a card, "Holotipo ♂" ["Allotipo ♀"] handwr.; "Holotypus" ["Allotipo"] handwr. with black ink on red painted paper; "Chaco Formosa / III.85 / Asilitae" handwr., folded (I glue the unfolded label on a piece of stronger paper); "Mallophora / Dallasi / Gemignani" handwr.; "synonymous of / M. robusta (Wied.)" typed, folded; "Museo Nacional / Buenos Aires" handwr. "MACN-En / 7612 [7613, 7614]" print., reverse.

Notes: There is a spec. labeled "Paratipo" from Paraguay, but neither a parat. nor Paraguay were mentioned in the original description; see at the corresponding list, below. Recorded as *Mallophora dallasi* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 74). The entry 26719 in the register book of the Entomological Division of the Museum refers to three asilids from "Chaco, Formosa" (*sic*) III.1885, probably from the trip to both prov. performed by Lynch Arribálzaga.

dissona [*Cylicomera*]. Lamas 1973a: 19, 25, 28–30, f. 17, 25, 40, 60, 98–100. Tucumán Prov., San Pedro de Colalao, **holot.** ♂, **parat.** ♂, ♀. Chubut Prov., Burmeister, **parat.** in MACN. Río Negro Prov.: Río Colorado. Buenos Aires Prov.: F. Solá. Santiago del Estero Prov.: Mistol and Icaño.

Note: The entry 6878 in the old general register book of the Museum refers to 15 dipters from Chaco Prov., Lynch Arribálzaga leg.

Notes: The localities differ, Baradero against Mercedes, but otherwise the labels seem authentic. Recorded as *Prolepsis fax* by Lamas (1973a: 36–38), who did not find the type in MACN, and put *T. brethesi* Gemignani as a new synonym.

La Rioja Prov.; the entries 21982 and 21983 refer to 3 Asilids from Catamarca Prov.: Concepción de Catamarca III.1928, M. Gómez leg.; the entry 30212 refers to one Asilid from Catamarca Prov., M. Gómez leg.

pluto (sub *Pluto*) [*Tolmerolestes*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1881: 111–114. Buenos Aires Prov.: Mercedes, San José de Flores, and Baradero.

pluto [*Prolepsis*]: Lamas 1973a: 38–40. *Nov. comb.*, and lectot. designation.

Lectot. pinned, “Baradero” handwr.; “*Tolmerolestes / Pluto* E. Lch. A.” handwr. by Lynch Arribálzaga, folded; “Lectotipo [print.] / *Tolmerolestes / pluto* Lynch Arrib. [handwr.] / G. Lamas des. 1972 [print.]” on yellowish orange paper, remainings of a black frame; “*Prolepsis pluto / (Lynch Arrib.)* [handwr.] / G. Lamas det. 1972 [print.]”, remainings of a black frame. “MACN-En / 7640” print., reverse.

Notes: San José de Flores is now a district of Buenos Aires City. Recorded as *Prolepsis pluto* new combination, with *T. rubripes* Lynch Arribálzaga as a new synonym, by Lamas (1973a: 38–40), who designates lectot. of both names.

rubripes [*Tolmerolestes*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1881: 114–115. San Luis Prov. XII.1879.

H. Martin [print.]” on bright pink paper); “*Psilonyx* [print.] / *tornowii* / (Brèthes) [handwr.] / Det. C.H. Martin [print.]”, black frame (the paralect. also “*Leptogaster* / *tornowii* [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.]”, glued on bright pink hardboard. “MACN-En / 7677 [7678]” print., reverse.

Notes: Lectot. designation not found, perhaps not published. There are two **slides**, with an antenna, and with mouth parts and an antenna, respectively, in slide coll. sub L5 and L6, without “type” labels. Currently in family Leptogastridae

ambrosetti [*Volucella*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 179–180. Misiones Prov.: Moconá, leg. Ambrosetti, ♂, ♀.

ambrosetti [*Copestylum*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 71. *Nova combin.*

Two synt. pinned, one without head, “Typus” print. with red ink, red frame; “Misiones [Misiones / Ambrosetti]” handwr., folded; “*Volucella* [V.] / *Ambrosetti*” handwr., folded; “*Syntypus*” print. on red paper, one of them “390”, “163” handwr., red frame, and “V. ambrosetti / F. Lynch Arribál.” handwr., green frame. “MACN-En / 7644 [7645]” print., reverse.

Note: Recorded as *Copestylum ambrosetti*, new combin., by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 71).

boliviiana [*Dolichogyna* (*D. [olichogyna]*)]. Lagrange 1993: 122–125, f. 9–16. Bolivia: Macizo Tunari 4300 m a.s.l., N°2296, **holot.** ♂, **parat.**, **four ♂ ex coll.** Zischka in coll. Duret.

Holot. ♂, a wing glued to the locality label, **four parat.** ♂, all pinned, “Bolivia / Tunari Massiv

[print.] (4300 m [handwr.] / ex coll. Zischka [print.], black frame; "Museo de La Plata [print.]/Dolychogyna boli.- / viana [handwr.] Det. [print.] Lagrange 1991 [handwr.]" ; "Holotipo" ["Paratipo"] print. on red paper, one parat. also: "Zischka coll." handwr. "MACN-En / 7646 [7647 through 7650]" print., reverse.

bonariensis [*Baccha*]. Brèthes 1905: 340–341, f. 1, 3. Buenos Aires: Palermo, **one spec.** in Museo Nacional (=MACN).

bonariensis [*Ocyptamus*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 71. *Nova combin.* Typus in MACN.

Notes: Recorded as *Ocyptamus bonariensis*, new comb., by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976:13), who say the ♂ type is in MACN. Palermo is a district in Buenos Aires City.

bonariensis [*Nausigaster*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 254–255. Buenos Aires City: Zoological Garden, leg. Holmberg, **one spec.**

Holot. pinned, head missing, "Typus" print. with red ink, red frame; "2163" handwr.; "Holotypus" print. on pink paper, remainings of a black frame; "Nausigaster / bonariensis n. sp. / Palermo" handwr. "MACN-En / 7652" print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded as *Nausigaster bonariensis* by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 92), who say the ♂ type is in MACN. The Zoological Garden lies in the Palermo district of Buenos Aires City.

brethesi (sub *Brèthesi*) [*Lepidostola*]. Shannon 1928: 573–574. Bolivia: Sara Prov. One ♂ 11863 in Museo Nacional (=MACN), leg. Steinbach 1916.

brethesi [*Lepidomyia*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 88.

Holot. ♂ pinned, head missing, "11863" handwr., red frame; "Bolivia" handwr. on green paper, black frame, reverse white; "Lepidostola / Brèthesi Shann." handwr.; "pulchra Will. / Bolivia" handwr., black frame; "Lepidostola / Mik" handwr., black frame; "iTYPUS!" handwr. by Brèthes? "MACN-En / 7681" print., reverse.

Note: *Lepidostola* Mik 1886 is an unjustified new name for *Lepidomyia* Loew 1864, *fide* Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 88).

One slide with two wings, "Salpingogaster / dactylopianus / Blnchd. [handwr. by Blanchard] / Lab. Zoología Agrícola / det. [print.]", in slide collection *sub S 47*. "MACN-En / 7679" print.

Notes: The spec. were not found. The slide has no type label.

Note: Recorded as *Argentinomyia grandis* by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 57), who say the type is in MACN.

insularis [*Tropidia*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 238–240. Paraná River Delta, Antequera Is., **one ♂, one ♀** leg. Holmberg.

One synt. pinned, damaged, "Typus" print. with red ink, red frame; "Isla Antequera" handwr., folded; "163", "424" handwr., red frame; "Syntypus" print. on pink paper, remainings of a black frame "Tropidia/insularis / F. Lynch a." handwr. by Lynch Arribálzaga. "MACN-En / 7655" print., reverse.

Note: Recorded as *Tropidia insularis* by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 120), who say the types, ♂ and ♀, are in MACN. One synt. not found.

limae [*Mesograpta*]. Brèthes 1920: 30–31. Perú: Lima.

limae [Toxomerus]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 51. *Nova combin.*

lizeri (sub *Lizeri*) [*Helophilus*]. Brèthes 1914: 97–98. Córdoba Prov.: La Cumbre, **one ♂**.

lizeri [*Habromyia*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 101. *Nova combin.*

Holot. pinned, "120" handwr.; "Helophilus / Lizeri Brèthes" handwr. by Brèthes; "Holotypus [print.] / lizeri Bretes (sic) [handwr.] [obverse] / Thompson / 97 [handwr., reverse]" on red paper, remainings of a black frame. "MACN-En / 7657" print., reverse.

Note: Recorded as *Habromyia lizeri*, new comb., by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 101), who say *Meromacrus vittata* Hull 1937, from Tucumán, is a new synonym.

missionera [*Volucella*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 184. Misiones: alto [río] Uruguay, two ♀, may be = *V. punctigera*, described from ♂.

missionera [*Copestylum*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 79. *Nova combin.*

Note: Recorded as *Meromacrus nectarinoides* new comb. by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 112), who say the types could be in MACN.

obscuripennis [*Volucella*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 180. Misiones Prov. Monteagudo, near Uruguay River, Picada de Paggi, leg. Ambrosetti.

obscuripennis [*Copestylum*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 80. *Nova combin.*

One synt. pinned, "Typus" print. with red ink, red frame; "Misiones / Monteagudo / Amb." handwr.; "163" handwr.; "Syntypus" print. on red paper, remainings of a black frame; "Volucella / obscuripennis / F. picturata [*Volucella*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 184–185. Misiones Prov.: depart. Monteagudo, Picada Paggi, near Uruguay River, leg. Ambrosetti, **two ♀**.

picturatum [*Copestylum*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 82. *Nova combin.*

One synt. ♀ pinned, right wing extended, left wing backdriven over the abdomen, "Typus" print. with red ink, red frame; "Misiones / Ambr." handwr.; "V. picturata / F. Lch. A." handwr.; "V. / picturata / F. Lynch Arribál." handwr., green frame. "MACN-En / 7662" print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded as *Copestylum picturatum* new comb. by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 82), who say the ♀ types are in MACN. One synt. not found.

planifrons [*Masarygus*]. Brèthes 1909: 442–443, f. a–g. Buenos Aires: Urquiza 8.XII.1908, **one ♂, one ♀** in Museo Nacional (=MACN), the ♂ look like *Odontomyia inermis*, Stratiomyidae; they were repelled by ants (*Camponotus mus*) at a heavily bored wooden pillar; *sub* Masarygidae nov.

planifrons [*Microdon (Masarygus)*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 61.

Four synt. pinned, "Bs. Aires [on one: 8.XII.08] / 8.XII.08 [on one: Bs. Aires] / J. B." handwr. by Brèthes, black frame; "Masarygus / planifrons" handwr. by Brèthes; "Syntype" handwr. on red paper. "MACN-En / 7663 [7664, 7665, 7666]" print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded under *Microdon* (*Masarygus*) by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 61), who say the types, ♂ & ♀, are in MACN, and in Mus. Civ. Milano, Italy, where they examined them. Urquiza is a district in Buenos Aires City.

rubriventris [*Microdon*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1891: 128–129. Buenos Aires Prov. Chacabuco; abundant in spring; near *M. bidens*.

One synt. in double mounting, with the pointed half of a pin and a block of cardboard, “Chacabuco” handwr. on dirty white paper; “*Microdon / rubriventris* [hardly legible] / Lynch” handwr., folded, glued, with several pinholes, with a blue, ornamented frame. spinithorax [*Temnocera*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 190–192. **Type ♀** from Chaco Prov.: Azara, leg. Boman, XI.1888, in “Esc. Normal de Profes., B. Aires”. **Five spec.** ♂, ♀, Misiones, trip from high Uruguay River to high Paraná River, leg. Ambrosetti.

spinithorax [*Copestylum*]: Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman 1976: 84. *Nov. comb.*

Holot. pinned, abdomen and one leg glued to a card, “Typus” print. with red ink, red frame; “Azara / IV16.89 / Bm” handwr.; “Holotypus” print. on pink paper, remainings of a black frame; “*Temnocera / spinithorax / F. Lynch a.*” handwr. by Lynch Arribálzaga. Three **parat.?** on one pin, “*Temnocera / spinithorax / n. sp.*” handwr. by Lynch Arribálzaga. “MACN-En / 7667 [7668, 7669, 7670]” print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded under *Copestylum* by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 84), who say the type ♀ is in MACN. The dates differ, but otherwise the labels seem authentic.

tibialis [*Volucella* (*Volosyrpha*)]. Shannon 1928: 575–576. Misiones Prov., type ♀ in Museo Nacional (=MACN), *sub* 7600, Spegazzini leg. 1907. Type species of the new subgenus.

Holot. ♀ pinned, one hind leg detached and glued to a card, “7600” handwr., red frame; “Misiones” handwr. on green paper, black frame, reverse white; “*Volucella / tibialis Snn.*” handwr.; “Typus!” handwr. “MACN-En / 7680” print., reverse.

Notes: Recorded as *Copestylum rufitarse nom. nov. pro tibiale* Shannon non Macquart 1846, and

type ♀ in Museo Nacional, Buenos Aires, *fide* Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 3).

Notes: Recorded as *Proctacanthus cruentus* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 78). Type not found.

cuyanus [*Asilus*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 175–178. Mendoza Prov.

Notes: Recorded as “Gen.? *cuyanus*” by Martin & Papavero (1970: 88), who state that the genus is uncertain; *Asilus* is palaearctic. Type(s) not found.

distinguendus [*Scylaticus*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1881: 121–124. Buenos Aires Prov.: Chacabuco, ♂, ♀, F. Lynch Arribálzaga leg.

Notes: Recorded as *Scylaticus distinguendus* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 17). Types not found.

fasciata [*Asicya*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 227–229. Buenos Aires Prov.: Baradero, collected on *Eucalyptus globulus*.

Notes: Recorded as *Laphystia fasciata* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 9). Type(s) not found.

imitator [*Asilus*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1883: 79. Mendoza Prov., ♂, near *A. cuyanus*.

Notes: Recorded as “Gen? *imitator*” by Martin & Papavero (1970: 89), who state that the genus is uncertain; *Asilus* is palaearctic. Type not found.

leucophaea [*Dasythrix*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 55–57. Buenos Aires, in Berg coll.

Notes: Recorded as ?*Nusa leucophaea* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 41). Type(s) not found.

scutellaris [*Mallophora*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 254–256. Misiones Prov., ♀ in bad condition.

Notes: Recorded as *Mallophora scutellaris* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 76). Type not found.

tucma (sub *Tucma*) [*Dicranus*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 26–28; 1881: 124. Tucumán Prov.

Notes: Recorded as *Dicranus tucma* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 76). Type(s) not found.

violaceithorax [*Ceratotaenia*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 52–55. Buenos Aires Prov.

Notes: Recorded as *Cerotainia violaceithorax* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 52). *Ceratotaenia* Sching. is an unjustified emendation of *Cerotainia* Sching 1866. Type(s) not found.

vittatus [*Proctacanthus*]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 261–264. Misiones Prov., ♂, ♀

Note: Recorded as *Proctacanthus vittatus* by Martin & Papavero (1970: 79). Types not found.

Syrphidae

bonariensis [*Microdon*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1891: 194–195. Buenos Aires Prov.: Baradero, one ♀.

Note: Recorded under *Microdon* (*Microdon*) by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 64), who say that the type should be in MACN. Type not found.

dactylopianus [*Salpingogaster*]. Blanchard 1938: 348–351, f. 2, 8. Catamarca Prov.: Los Armadores 17.III.1938; Entre Ríos Prov. 26.IV.1397 (sic, pro 1937), a parasite of the coccid *Dactylopius indicus*, leg. Hayward, “cotypi” [=synt.] in author’s collection.

Note: Types not found. A slide with wings is recorded in the main list, above.

guntherii (sub *Güntherii*) [*Holmbergia*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1891: 197–198, f. 3. Near Buenos Aires City, one spec., leg. Günther.

Notes: Recorded as *Microdon* (*Rhopalosyrphus*) *guentherii*, new comb., by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 60), who say the type may be in MACN. Type not found.

patagonus [*Syrphus*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 115–116. Patagonia: [Santa Cruz Prov.]: Río Gallegos, one spec., could be a variety of *S. 8-maculatus* Walker 1837.

Note: Recorded as *Syrphus octomaculatus*, new synonymy, along with *gayi* Macquart 1842 and *testastaceicornis* Macquart 1850, by Thompson,

Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 60), who say the type(s) may be in MACN. Type not found.

rospigliosii (sub *Rospigliosii*) [*Volucella*]. Brèthes 1920: 31. Perú: Chanchamayo.

Notes: Recorded as *Copestylum rospigliosi*, new comb., by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 83), who say the type may be in MACN. Type(s) not found.

testaceipes [*Argentinomyia*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1891: 199–200, f. 4. Buenos Aires Prov.: Chacabuco, one ♀ on gramineous grasses.

Notes: Recorded under *Argentinomyia* (*Argentinomyia*) by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 57), who say the type may be in MACN. Type not found.

willistonii (sub *Willistonii*) [*Mesograpta*]. F. Lynch Arribálzaga 1892: 54–55. Misiones, near Posadas.

Notes: Recorded under *Toxomerus* by Thompson, Vockeroth & Sedman (1976: 56), who say the type may be in MACN. Type(s) not found.

Note: *Fidena coscaroni* is a replacement name, it deserves no type.

magellanicus [*Tabanus*]. Philippi 1865.

One spec. ♂ on a pointed card, “Argentina / Ushuaia / Tierra d. Fuego / 26-I-49 [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.]”, black frame; “Alotipo” print. on pink paper, black frame; “Agelanius / magellanicus / (Phil.) / Barr. et Dur. det. 55”, handwr.; “T.11” handwr. on green paper.

Notes: A synonym of *Dasybasis trita* (Walker 1857) *fide* Coscarón (1967a: 123); recorded as *Dasybasis (Dasybasis) tritus* by Fairchild (1971: 42), and as *Dasybasis trita* by Coscarón & Papavero (2009: 76–77). The spec. was collected, and labeled as allot., much later.

melanogaster [*Tabanus*]. Brèthes 1911: 482. [Buenos Aires Prov.]: La Plata.

One spec. ♀ pinned, “Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / 190_ / C. Bruch” print., black frame; “Rio / Santiago / 30.XII.915” handwr. by Bruch; “Alotipo” print. on pink paper, black frame; “Tabanus / melanogaster Brèth. / Barr. et. Dur. det. ‘55” handwr. **Two spec.**, pinned, “J. Brèthes / Buenos Aires / 20.XI.1903” handwr. by Brèthes, black frame; “Argentina [print.] / Tandil [handwr.] / Bs. Aires [print.]”, black frame;

“Tabanus / acer Brèthes” handwr. by Brèthes; “Cotypus” print. on red paper; “Aloparatipo” handwr. on pink paper; “Tabanus / melanogaster Brèth. / Barr. et Dur. det. ‘55” handwr.; “7899” handwr., black frame. **One spec.** pinned, “Argentina [print.] / Tigre [handwr.] / Bs. Aires [print.]”, black frame; “Tabanus / signativentris / Brèth.” handwr., green frame; “35576” handwr., red frame; “Aloparatipo” print. on pink paper; “Tabanus / melanogaster Brèth. / Barr. et Dur. det. ‘55” handwr. **One spec.** pinned, “Tabanus / rubescens / Macq. [handwr.] / det. Orfila [print.]”; “13736” handwr., red frame; “Aloparatipo” handwr. on pink paper; “Tabanus / melanogaster Brèth. / Barr. et Dur. det. ‘55” handwr.

Note: None of these was mentioned in the original description. The holot. is recorded at the main list, above.

missionum [*Tabanus*]. Macquart 1838: 186. Brasil: “Missions”.

missionum [*Dasybasis*]: Coscarón & Philip 1967a: 127–131, pl. 47A–I, 48A–D. ♂ described, but not formally designated as an allot.

One spec. ♂ pinned, “Colonia / Macías, S. Fé / X-42 / Col. Viana” handwr.; “Dasybasis / missio-num / ? [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.]”, black frame; “Allotype” print. on red paper; “Dasybasis ♂ / missionum (Mcq.) / det. Coscarón & Phil. / 1965” handwr.

Note: The spec. was collected, and labeled as the allot. much later; it was not formally designated as an allot.

opacum [*Pseudoselasoma*]. Brèthes 1911: 475. San Juan Prov.

One “homeotipo” from “San Juan Wb”, seemingly seen by Brèthes.

Notes: “Homeotipo” is not an accepted category of types. The holot. is recorded at the main list, above.

Asilidae

dallasi (*sub Dallasi*) [*Mallophora*]. Gemignani 1931: 264–265. “Chaco-Formosa” 26719, **holot.** ♂, **allot.** ♀ in MACN.

One spec. pinned, “Paratipo” handwr.; “paraty-pus” handwr. on red painted paper; “Mallophora / Dallasi / Gemignani” handwr.; “synonymous of / *M. robusta* (Wied.)” typed, folded; “Museo Nacional / Buenos Aires” handwr.; “Paraguay / Arias-cué / III.23.85 / Asilitae / n° 17” handwr., folded (I glue this label on stronger paper, and as the pin get broken, I remount the spec. in double

mounting, on a piece of cork).

Note: Neither a paratype nor Paraguay were mentioned in the original description. The holot. ♂ and the allot. ♀ are recorded in the main list, above.

lugubris [Mallophora]. E. Lynch Arribálzaga 1880: 252–254. Misiones Prov., ♂, ♀.

One spec. pinned, left wing and fore and hind legs missing, “Holotipo” handwr. on red paper; “M. lugubris / ♂ E. Lch.” handwr., folded, damaged (I glue it to stronger paper); “Formosa / III.85 / Asilitae” handwr., folded; “M. lugubris / E. Lynch Arr. [handwr.] / Mus. Nac. Hist. Natural Buenos Aires [print.]”, black frame; “Museo Nacional / Buenos Aires” handwr.

Notes: Formosa was not mentioned in the original publication; moreover the spec. was collected later. A synt. is recorded in the main list, above.

Hepper” handwr.; “wh. hs. / palp. tib./ yel. callus” in running handwr.; “1:1.8” handwr.; “eyes (relax) / bl. black / unbanded?” running handwr.; “Dasybasis / caprii n. sp. / det. Cosc. + Phil. 65” handwr.

cumelafquen [Dasybasis]. Coscarón 1962a: 43–45, f. 14–26. Chubut Prov.: Fontana Lake, **holot. ♀** in **Museo de La Plata**, **one parat.** in **Instituto Nacional de Microbiología** [now ANLIS].

One parat. pinned, end of abdomen missing, head detached and glued, “Paratipo” print. on pink paper, black frame; “Lago Fontana / Chubut / 14-II-61 / Col. Coscarón” handwr. paper; “1” handwr., circumvested.

fontanensis [Dasybasis]. Coscarón 1962a: 41–43, f. 1–13. Chubut Prov.: Fontana Lake. **Holot. ♀, parat. two ♀** in **Museo de La Plata**, **two ♀** in **MACN**.

Six parat. pinned, “Paratipo” print. on red paper, black frame; “Lago Fontana / [Chubut, on four] / II.61 / Col. Coscarón” handwr.; “Dasybasis / fontanensis / Cosc. / Det. Coscarón” handwr.

One of them, also: “1:2.2” handwr.; “Comp. w. Type of / *Styp. patagonica* End. / on loan of Berlin Mus. / by G.B. Fairchild 1963 / NOT in agreement” handwr.

Notes: These parat. were not mentioned, but the labels are authentic. Two parat. are recorded at the main list, above.

picea [Dasybasis kroberi var.]. Coscarón & Philip 1967a: 94

One “parat.” pinned, “Paratipo” print. on pink paper, black frame, “Putre [handwr.] Arica / Prov. Tarapaca [print.] / 23 Nov. [handwr.] 1952 CHILE / L.E. Pena [print.]”; “eyes unbanded” handwr.; “1:1.7” typed; “Phil.” [handwr.]; “Dasybasis / kroberi v. picea / nov. / Cosc. & Phil. 1965” handwr., black frame.

Note: A *nomen nudum*, it was described as a variety after 1960.

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
